# 1- POLICY FOR THE CONDUCT OF ANNUAL EXAMINATION AND DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF SSC AND HSSC 2020 AND 2021 IN THE BACKDROP OF COVID-19

## Salient features of the policy are as below:

1. All the candidates who were to appear in class 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> examination 2020 may be exempted from exams in the wake of COVID-19 and they would appear only in 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Annual examination in 2021 respectively.
2. The papers of the candidates, who appeared in the 10<sup>th</sup> class examination 2020, may be marked and result be declared Accordingly.
3. The candidates who have qualified all the subjects in HSSC Part-I, may be awarded the same marks in Part-II. The candidates who have qualified HSSC Part-I examination but failed as whole in part-II (year 2019) may be awarded the same marks as obtained in Part-I.
4. The candidate who have qualified their part-II examination but failed in various subjects in part-I and now appearing as compartment case, may be awarded the same marks as they have obtained in theory of part-II. Whereas, the marks obtained in practical exams earlier shall remain the same.
5. The candidates appearing for improvement in part-II of HSSC Examination as whole may be awarded the same marks as they have obtained in the theory of part-I. Whereas, the marks obtained in the practical exams earlier shall remain the same.
6. The candidates appearing for improvement in various subjects may be awarded the highest marks obtained in the relevant subject(s) in their Part-I or Part-II of HSSC Examination. Whereas, the marks obtained in practical earlier shall remain the Same.
7. The candidates appearing for improvement in the HSSC Part-I may be awarded the same marks as they have obtained in theory of part-II (Year2019).
8. The candidates appearing to avail their last chance for passing the examination may be awarded average marks obtained in passed subjects in the relevant part.
9. The candidates who have failed up-to 40% of the subjects of part-I (HSSC) and appearing in part-II may be awarded average marks obtained in passing subjects for failed subjects and their marks thus obtained in Part-I may be doubled for Part-II.
10. The candidates appearing for various subjects of part-I and II (HSSC) as compartment case, may be awarded average marks obtained in passing subjects respectively.
11. Practical exams may not be conducted and marks for practical (only for qualifying candidates) for both SSC and HSSC may be awarded as follows:  
50% marks of the total practical marks may be granted to all candidates while remaining  
50% marks may be awarded proportionate to the theory marks in the relevant subject.
12. The candidates of HSSC falling in the following categories will be offered Special Covid-19 Examination only, which would be held as and when prescribed by PBCC. Special Examination shall be conducted only for HSSC Part-II, this must be read in continuation with Sr. # 16.
  - I. The candidate who have applied for composite (Part I-II) examination.
  - II. The candidates (Part-II) who absented themselves in one or two subjects in part-I or got their result of some subjects of part-I cancelled.
  - III. The candidates appearing for various additional subjects.
  - IV. The candidates appearing for Shahadat ul Sanavia and Shahadat Ul Khasa.
13. Additional marks up-to 3% (of obtained score in Part-I) may be added in the aggregate marks to all candidates who are not offered the special Exams opportunity. This is to be fair with the students for their additional efforts to improve their marks.
14. The marks of the candidates, mentioned in Sr. #01 and availing the above said policy may be calculated similar to the guidelines above but in reverse order.
  - I. Candidates who were appearing in SSC composite Exams 2020 and could not be examined for 9<sup>th</sup> class, their marks may be doubled but in reverse order.
  - II. Candidates who have passed 10<sup>th</sup> class examinations in 2019 and were appearing in failed subjects of 9<sup>th</sup> class, the same marks may be awarded in the relevant subjects for 9<sup>th</sup> class.
  - III. Cases of marks improvement in 9<sup>th</sup> class only and additional subjects may be dealt as 14(I) above.
15. The boards may mention in the transcript and in the certificate of SSC and HSSC (where applicable) that the marks awarded for part-II (2020) and Part-I (2021) are the best prediction of the performance and has been awarded based on the formula And guidelines approved by the respective Government/statutory bodies, hence considered as valid and fair.



16. If any candidate does not accept the above mentioned policy or award on the analogy of previous marks, he/she may opt to appear in the special examination. However, the candidates must declare their decision to their respective boards within the prescribed time frame, as may be announced by the PBCC, otherwise it may be presumed that they agree with the said policy. No response may be considered as acceptance to the said policy. The candidates who send their declaration form within due date, may not be awarded result transcripts or certificates. They may be allowed to sit in the Special Exams and their already paid fee may be adjusted for the said examinations. However, these recommendations may be amended by the Punjab education reforms committee.
17. Any problem/situation arising which is not covered by the above policy will be referred to Punjab Boards Committee of Chairpersons (PBCC) for its resolution whose decision will be considered final.

- 1 وہ تمام امیدواران (طلباء و طالبات) جنہوں نے سال 2020ء میں جماعت نہم اور جماعت سال اول (گیارہویں) کے امتحانات میں شامل ہونا تھا انہیں کرونا وائرس (Covid-19) کی وجہ سے اس امتحان سے استثنیٰ حاصل ہوگا اور وہ اب صرف بالترتیب دہم اور سال دوم (بارہویں) کے سالانہ امتحان برائے سال 2021ء میں شامل ہوں گے۔
- 2 تمام امیدواران جو سالانہ امتحان جماعت دہم برائے سال 2020ء کا امتحان دے چکے تھے ان کے پرچوں کی جانچ پڑتال (مارکنگ) اور نتائج کا اعلان اسی کے مطابق کیا جائے گا۔
- 3 تمام ایسے امیدواران جنہوں نے گیارہویں/سال اول (HSSC Part-1) کے تمام مضامین پاس کر لئے تھے ان کو یہی نمبر (مضمون وار) سال دوم (HSSC Part-II) میں بھی دے دیئے جائیں گے۔ ایسے امیدواران جنہوں نے سال اول (HSSC Part-I) کا امتحان تو (مکمل طور پر) پاس کر لیا تھا لیکن سال دوم (HSSC Part-II) کے امتحان (سال 2019ء) میں مکمل فیل ہو گئے ان کو سال اول (پارٹ I) میں حاصل کردہ نمبر دیئے جائیں گے۔
- 4 ایسے تمام امیدواران جنہوں نے سال دوم (پارٹ II) کا امتحان (مکمل) پاس کر لیا تھا لیکن سال اول (پارٹ I) کے مختلف مضامین (پرچہ جات) میں فیل ہو گئے تھے اور اب کمپارٹمنٹ کیس کے طور پر (ان فیل شدہ پرچوں کا) امتحان دینا تھا ان امیدواران کو سال دوم میں انہی مضامین کی تھیوری کے پرچے میں حاصل کردہ نمبر دے دیئے جائیں گے جبکہ عملی امتحان (پریکٹیکل) میں پہلے ہی حاصل کردہ نمبر برقرار رہیں گے۔

- 7 ایسے امیدواران جنہوں نے اپنے سال اول (HSSC Part-1) کے نمبروں میں بہتری (Improvement) کیلئے امتحان دینا تھا انہیں پارٹ II (سال 2019ء) میں تھیوری کے مضامین میں حاصل کردہ نمبر دیئے جائیں گے (جبکہ پریکٹیکل عملی امتحان کے.....؟)
- 8 ایسے امیدواران جنہوں نے اپنے آخری موقع (چانس) میں امتحان پاس کرنے کیلئے شامل ہونا تھا انہیں متعلقہ حصے (پارٹ) کے پاس کردہ (کامیاب شدہ) مضامین میں حاصل کردہ نمبروں کی اوسط (Average) دی جائے گی۔
- 9 ایسے امیدواران جو سال اول (HSSC Part-I) میں 40 فیصد (تک) مضامین میں فیل ہو گئے اور (اب) سال دوم (Part-II) کے امتحان میں شامل ہونا تھا انہیں پاس کردہ مضامین میں حاصل کردہ نمبروں کی اوسط فیل شدہ مضامین میں دی جائے گی اور اس طرح حاصل کردہ سال اول (پارٹ I) کے نمبروں کو سال دوم (پارٹ II) کیلئے (ڈبل/ڈگن) کر دیا جائے گا۔
- 10 ایسے امیدواران جنہوں نے سال اول (HSSC Part-1) اور سال دوم (HSSC Part-II) کے مختلف مضامین کا امتحان بطور کمپارٹمنٹ کیس دینا تھا انہیں پاس کردہ مضامین میں حاصل کردہ نمبروں کی اوسط بالترتیب دی جائے گی۔ (اوسط نمبر)
- 11 عملی امتحانات (پریکٹیکل) منعقد نہیں ہوں گے اور عملی امتحانات (پریکٹیکل) کے نمبر (صرف کامیاب/پاس شدہ امیدواران) دونوں امتحانات ثانوی (SSC) اور اعلیٰ ثانوی (HSSC) کیلئے درج ذیل طریقے سے دیئے جائیں گے۔
- عملی امتحان (پریکٹیکل) کے کل نمبروں کا 50 فیصد تمام (کامیاب) امیدواران کو دے دیئے جائیں گے جبکہ بقیہ 50 فیصد نمبر متعلقہ مضمون کی تھیوری میں حاصل کردہ نمبروں کے تناسب (Proportionate) کے طور پر دیئے جائیں گے۔
- 12 اعلیٰ ثانوی (HSSC) امتحان کے امیدوار جو درج ذیل کیٹیگریز میں آتے ہیں انہیں صرف خصوصی/پیش امتحان Covid-19 میں شمولیت کی پیشکش کی جائے گی جس کا انعقاد پنجاب بورڈز کمیٹی آف چیئرمین (PBCC) کی طرف سے متعین/تجویز کردہ وقت اور طریقہ کار کے مطابق ہوگا ان (شوقوں/نکات) کو لازماً سیریل نمبر 16 کے تسلسل میں پڑھا جائے گا۔
- (i) امیدواران جنہوں نے کمپوزٹ (پارٹ I اور پارٹ II) کے امتحان کیلئے فارم جمع کروائے۔
- (ii) سال دوم (پارٹ II) کے امیدوار جو سال اول (پارٹ I) کے ای یا دو مضامین میں غیر حاضر ہو گئے یا سال اول (پارٹ I) کے کچھ مضامین کا نتیجہ منسوخ کروایا ہو۔
- (iii) امیدوار جو مختلف اضافی (Additional) مضامین کے امتحان کیلئے شامل ہو رہے تھے۔

- 13- ایسے تمام امیدوار جن کو خصوصی امتحان (Covid-19) کی پیشکش نہیں کی گئی 3 فیصد اضافی نمبر (سال اول پارٹ I کے حاصل کردہ نمبروں پر) ان کے مجموعی نمبروں میں شامل کئے جائیں گے۔ یہ ایسے طلبہ کیلئے جنہوں نے بہتر نمبروں کے حصول کیلئے کوششیں کی ہیں ”عین انصاف ہوگا“۔
- 14- ایسے امیدوار جن کا ذکر سیریل نمبر 1 پر کیا گیا ہے اور وہ متذکرہ بالا پالیسی سے مستفید ہونا چاہتے ہیں ان کے نمبر ان ہی رہنما اصولوں کی بنیاد پر شمار کئے جائیں گے تاہم اس کی ترتیب معکوس (الٹ) ہوگی۔
- (i) امیدوار جو ثانوی (SSC) کمپوزٹ (جامع) امتحان 2020ء میں شامل ہونے جا رہے تھے لیکن ان کا جماعت نمبر کا امتحان نہ لیا جا سکے ان کے نمبر معکوس ترتیب میں دگنا (ڈبل) ہو جائیں گے۔
- (ii) امیدوار جنہوں نے جماعت دہم کا امتحان سال 2019ء میں پاس کر لیا تھا اور جماعت نہم کے فیصل شدہ (33 فیصد سے کم نمبروں والے) مضامین کے امتحان میں شامل ہونے جا رہے تھے انہیں جماعت نہم کیلئے اسی متعلقہ مضمون میں جماعت دہم میں حاصل کردہ نمبر دے دیئے جائیں گے۔
- (iii) جماعت نہم میں نمبروں میں بہتری (امپر وومنٹ) اور اضافی مضامین کیلئے امتحان دینے والے امیدواروں کے کیسز کو متذکرہ بالا شیق نمبر (i) 14 کے تحت نمٹایا جائے گا۔
- 15- تعلیمی بورڈز میٹرک اور انٹرمیڈیٹ امتحانات کے عکسی نتائج (زلٹ کارڈ) اور ٹھیکٹیٹ (اسناد) میں (جہاں بھی اس کا اطلاق ہو) یہ تحریر (ذکر) کریں گے کہ پارٹ (II) 2020ء اور پارٹ فرسٹ (2021ء) میں دیئے گئے نمبر ان کا رکردگی کی بہترین پیش گوئی کرتے ہیں اور یہ نمبر متعلقہ حکومت/قانونی نظم (ادارے) کے منظور کردہ طریقہ کار (فارمولے) اور رہنما اصولوں کی بنیادوں پر دیئے گئے ہیں لہذا درست اور منصفانہ متصور ہوں۔

## 2- Announcement of Secondary School Certificate result 2020

A simple and graceful ceremony was held in the meeting room of the Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Faisalabad on 19-09-2020 to announce secondary school certificate result. The ceremony was headed by Chairperson BISE FSD Prof. DR. Tayybah

Shaheen, who on line the result at 05.00 pm sharp. The ceremony was also attended by Secretary BISE FSD Prof. Ch Muhammad Afzal, Controller BISE FSD Naveed Qureshi and Branch officers of the BISE FSD. Controller BISE FSD Naveed Qureshi shared the details of the result. According to details a total of 160526 students submitted admission forms in the board office but only 157448 appeared in the examination ,out of which 124513 passed



the said examination giving a passing percentage of 79.08%. He further explained that BISE FSD had established 535 examination centers for the facilitation of students. He added that these results are prepared with utmost care and attention in the backdrop of COVID-19 and chances of error are very minute. BISE FSD along with all boards of Punjab have introduced the grading system in the results and now the students will have results in percentile rather than simple percentage. This will minimize the race for numbers and will ignite the thirst for knowledge among the students. He added that positions have not been declared this year in the backdrop of COVID-19.



### 3- Announcement of Higher Secondary School Certificate result 2020

Higher Secondary School Certificate is the first stepping stone in a student's professional life. Owing to CORONA virus epidemic, exams of Intermediate could not be conducted this year. This posed a great challenge to Government of Pakistan and Boards all over the Pakistan

to dig out a way to promote students to the next classes while at the same time keeping in view the marks of students as the marks of HSSC are very crucial for admissions in Professional colleges/universities. However, after due deliberations of all stake holders, policy for promotion of students to the next classes was formulated by Government by taking in account all possible factors. After the formal approval of policy for promotion of students a simple and graceful



ceremony was held in the meeting room of the BISE FSD on 22-09-2020 to announce Higher Secondary School Certificate result.

Chairperson BISE FSD Prof. DR. Tayybah Shaheen was the chief guest who on lined the result at 05-10 pm sharp. The ceremony was also attended by Secretary BISE FSD Prof. Ch Afzal, Controller BISE FSD Naveed Qureshi and Branch officers of the BISE board. Controller BISE FSD Naveed Qureshi shared the details of the result. According to details a total of 104001 students appeared in the examination out of which 90556 passed the said examination giving a passing percentage of 87.07%, while 13321 students were found eligible for special examination. It was noteworthy that Govt. allowed students to appear in the special examination who were not satisfied with their number allotted according to the given formula.

### 4- Audit Branch

Maintaining the tradition of introducing board branches to general public to make them aware of how board works for public service, audit branch is presented in this publication.

Audit branch is the custodian of accountability and fair play in the BISE FSD in utilizing public money. It is headed by an officer of Punjab Local Fund and audit/Finance department on deputation to BISE FSD. Mr. Gulfraz Ahmad Minhas is the present Audit officer of BISE FSD. He has a vast experience in audit and financial matters.

Audit branch in BISE FSD is conducting Pre-audit of all the payments from board funds in accordance with the government rules/ regulations and board calendar. Recently, on the directions of board administration, it has also taken up the assignment of annual audit (internal). Audit branch BISE FSD is fully determined towards its official duties with a first and foremost aim to help ensure the board management in transparent, fair, economical, efficient and effective use of public money.



### 5- National Sports Gala (2019-2020)

Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Faisalabad not only believes in official excellence but it also pounds a lot on the extracurricular activities. Achievements of BISE FSD in all Pakistan Sports Gala are one of its glimpse.
